Highland Hikes & Horse Trails: Kyrgyzstan & Kazakhstan

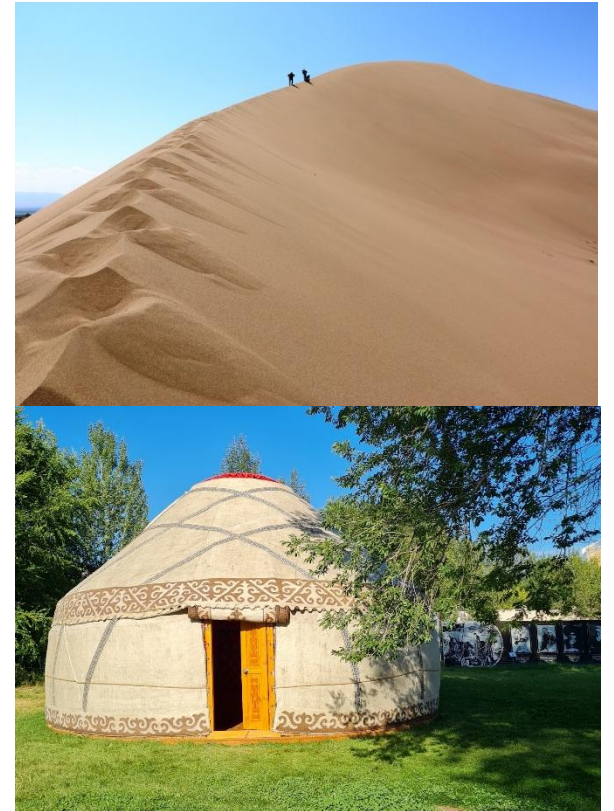
(12 Days, 11 Nights)

Day 1 – Singing Dunes & Steppe Silence

Begin in Almaty, then venture into Altyn Emel's vast steppe, surreal Singing Dunes, and Ili River's thriving ecosystems.

- Depart Almaty by morning for a 3-hour drive into **Altyn Emel's desert-steppe** expanse.
- Climb the **Singing Dune**, a 150-metre-high sand ridge that "sings" like an organ when dry grains shift underfoot.
- Explore the **Ili River basin**, spotting migratory birds and wildlife thriving along the riverbanks.
- Learn about the park's geology, from **multicoloured sands to wind-sculpted ridges**, while taking in sweeping steppe views.
- Spend the **night in a traditional Kazakh yurt**, under a star-filled desert sky.

Accommodation: Traditional Kazakh Yurt



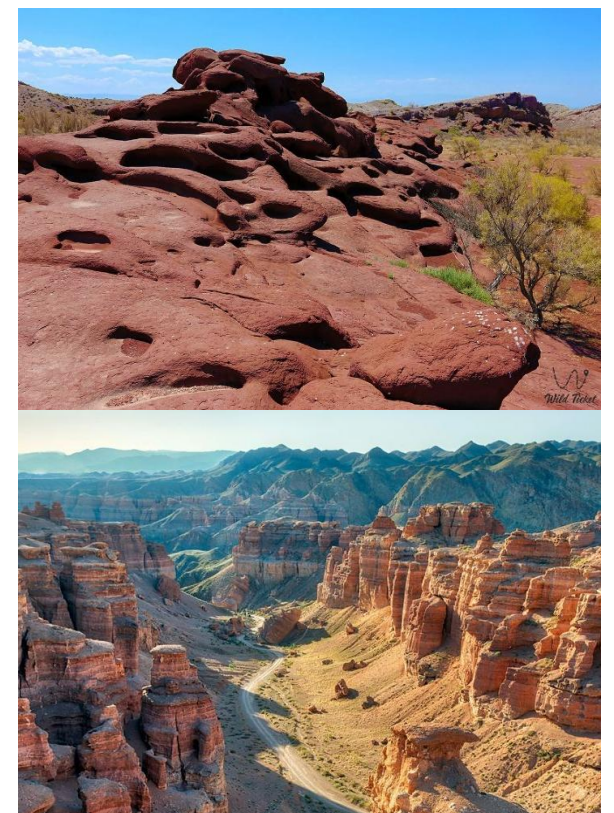
Day 2 – Painted Mountains & Red Rock Wonders

Discover Altyn Emel's dramatic mountain ranges and continue into one of Kazakhstan's most iconic natural landmarks: Charyn Canyon.

- Visit the **Katutau and Aktau Mountains**, surreal ranges of colourful sediment and volcanic rock that resemble an alien landscape.
- Travel across desert roads (3 hours) to reach **Charyn Canyon**, often compared to the Grand Canyon for its deep gorges and striking red cliffs.
- **Hike 4 km through the Valley of Castles**, admiring towering sandstone pillars shaped by millennia of erosion.
- **Build a campfire, enjoy an outdoor dinner, and camp** beneath the starlit Kazakh sky, surrounded by canyon walls.

Accommodation: Outdoor camping by the Charyn river

Day 3 – Canyon Trails & Alpine Lakes

Wake to sunrise in the canyon before journeying toward alpine beauty. From rugged cliffs to shimmering mountain lakes, today offers a contrast of landscapes.

- Enjoy an outdoor breakfast at camp, followed by a 4 km hike out of Charyn Canyon.
- Travel 2 hours to **Saty village**, a rural settlement in the foothills.
- **Ride in a Soviet-era UAZ 4x4** over rugged tracks to reach the alpine gems of **Kolsai & Kaindy Lakes**.
- Hike 3 km around the lakes, where turquoise waters reflect forests of submerged trees and snow-capped peaks.
- Return to Saty village for dinner and rest in a cosy guesthouse.



Accommodation: Guesthouse in Saty Village

Day 4 – Across Borders & Cultures

From Kazakhstan’s borderlands, cross into Kyrgyzstan’s Issyk-Kul region, where mosques, churches, and Dungan cuisine await.

- Drive 3 hours to Kegen, and **cross the Kazakh–Kyrgyz border at the Karakara Valley**.
- Travel onward (3 hours) to **Karakol**, gateway to the Tian Shan Mountains.
- Visit the **wooden Dungan Mosque** and the **Holy Trinity Cathedral**, each reflecting unique cultural and religious traditions.
- **Taste Ashlyanfu**, a spicy noodle dish rooted in the Dungan community’s history.

Accommodation: Guesthouse in Karakol



Days 5–7 – (3 days, 2 nights) Horse riding through Alpine Valleys & High-Altitude Lakes

From Karakol, venture deep into Kyrgyzstan’s Tian Shan Mountains where horseback expeditions, hot springs, and alpine lakes create an unforgettable adventure. These three days immerse you in nomadic rhythms, combining cultural gateways with wilderness exploration.

- On Day 5, **ride through remote valleys on horseback** from Jolkolot to Altyn Arashan (4–5 hours), crossing rivers, alpine forests, and meadows.
- **Soak in hot springs** beneath snow-capped peaks, a nomadic tradition after long journeys.
- **Spend the night in a traditional Kyrgyz yurt** nestled in the lush valleys of the Altyn Arashan National Park.
- On Day 6, **trek toward Ala-Kul Lake (3,300m)**, leaving horses behind for the final climb to turquoise waters cradled by glaciers.
- Picnic by the lake before descending to the valley, surrounded by sweeping Tian Shan vistas.
- **Spend another night in traditional yurts**, warmed by stoves and star-filled skies.
- **Hike shorter trails around Altyn Arashan to spot wildlife**, mountain flowers, and glacial rivers.
- On Day 7, **return to Karakol on horseback**, tracing back the route through rivers, alpine forests, meadows (4 – 5 hours).

Day 8 – Fairytales in Stone & Soviet Ghosts

Travel the southern shores of Issyk-Kul, where fantastical canyons and forgotten Soviet towns lie in wait.

- Drive 3 hours to **Skazka Canyon (“Fairytale Canyon”)**, where multi-hued cliffs resemble dragons, castles, and mythical shapes.
- **Hike 2 km** (1.5 hours) through whimsical formations of rocks, sand and dust
- **Explore Kaji-Say, a half-abandoned Soviet mining and spa town** that once home to a large mining complex.
- Continue 1 hour to Tong village, where mountains meet the southern shore of Issyk-Kul.

Accommodation: Guesthouse in Tong

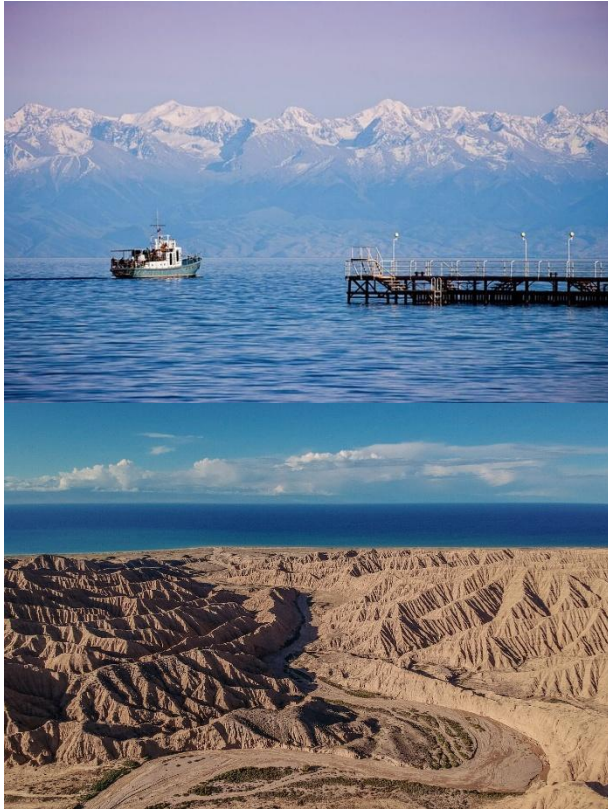


Day 9 – Shores, Canyons & Alpine Plateaus

A day of lake shores, hilltop panoramas, and canyon adventures, ending at one of Kyrgyzstan’s most iconic alpine lakes.

- **Swim or stroll along the pristine southern shore of Issyk-Kul.**
- Hike 2 hours up a hill near Bokonbaevo for panoramic views of the lake.
- Journey 1 hour to **Ak-Sai Canyon**, and hike 2 km across sculpted red cliffs.
- Drive 2 hours into the **high plateaus of Song-Kul Lake**, at 3,000m.
- **Overnight in traditional Kyrgyz yurts**

Accommodation: Traditional Kyrgyz Yurt in Song Kul



Day 10 – Nomadic Rhythms at Song-Kul

Experience life on the jailoo (summer pastures), where nomads have roamed for centuries.

- Explore the wide expanse of **Song-Kul Lake, Kyrgyzstan’s alpine jewel**.
- **Ride horses across open pastures** dotted with yurts.
- Learn about **nomadic customs, from dairy production to traditional games**.
- Watch the sun set over the vast lake, before gathering around a communal yurt stove.

Accommodation: Traditional Kyrgyz Yurt in Song Kul



Day 11 – Canyons, Towers & Return to Almaty

Leave the alpine pastures of Song-Kul and descend back into Kyrgyzstan’s valleys before crossing into Kazakhstan once more.

- Travel 6 hours from Song-Kul toward Bishkek.
- Stop at **Kok-Moynok Canyon** for a 2–3 km hike through Martian-like red rock landscapes.
- Visit the **Burana Tower**, an 11th-century Silk Road minaret and archaeological site near Tokmok.
- Arrive in Bishkek, then take a short flight (1 hour) across the border back to Almaty, Kazakhstan.
- Check in at a guesthouse in Almaty for the night.

Accommodation: Guesthouse in Almaty, Kazakhstan



Day 12 – Alpine Heights & Farewell

End your Central Asian adventure with a journey to one of Kazakhstan’s most beautiful alpine lakes before returning to Almaty.

- Depart Almaty early morning for a 2-hour drive into the **Tien Shan Mountains**.
- Arrive at **Big Almaty Lake**, a striking turquoise reservoir set at 2,500m altitude.
- Enjoy a **scenic hike (2–3 hours)** around the lake’s shores, surrounded by snow-capped ridges and pine forests.
- Return to Almaty (1 hour) by early afternoon.
- Trip concludes by 4 pm.
